Cloudbreak Life of Mine, Pilbara – Ministerial Statement 899 and Increase in abstraction and reinjection at Cloudbreak Mine – Ministerial Statement 1010 – Change to proposal approved under section 45C of the *Environmental Protection Act* 1986

Thank you for your letter of 14 June 2021, requesting approval of changes to the Cloudbreak Life of Mine, Pilbara (Ministerial Statement 899 (MS 899)) and increase in abstraction and reinjection at Cloudbreak Mine (Ministerial Statement 1010 (MS 1010)).

A section 45C request was originally submitted on 11 February 2021, then an additional request was submitted on 14 June 2021, which is prior to 23 October 2021. By operation of section 133M(6) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*, I am required to deal with this proposed change as if section 45C had not been amended.

I am satisfied that there is no reasonable possibility that the requested changes to the proposal, as described in Attachment 7 to MS 899 and Attachment 1 to MS 1010, will have a significant detrimental effect on the environment in addition to, or different from, the effect of the original proposal. Approval of the changes is therefore granted under section 45C of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*. This approval does not replace any responsibilities you may have for seeking approvals from other government agencies to implement the changes.

Please note implementation of the Cloudbreak Life of Mine, Pilbara proposal and increase in abstraction and reinjection at Cloudbreak Mine proposal, including the approved changes described in Attachment 7 to MS 899 and Attachment 1 to MS 1010, are subject to the conditions of MS 899 and MS 1010. The Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation may monitor the implementation of the proposal for the purpose of determining whether the implementation conditions are being complied with.
