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## 1. Decision summary

The delegated officer has determined to make amendments to licence L7084/1997/16. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This amendment report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

## 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### 2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L7084/1997/16 is held by the Shire of Donnybrook Balingup (licence holder) for the Donnybrook Waste Management Facility (the premises), located within a Portion of State Forest 27.

The premises relates to the categories and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing licence L7084/1997/16.

On 6 May 2024, the department initiated an amendment to licence L7084/1997/16. The amendment is limited to extending licence expiry date by three months to allow enough time to undertake the assessment of a renewal application received by the department on 28 March 2024.

## 3. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft amendment report on 7 June 2024. Subsequently the licence holder waived the consultation period on that same day and requested the licence be issued as soon as possible.

## 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this amendment report, the delegated officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

### 4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the revised licence as part of the amendment process.
