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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to works approval W6580/2021/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Application summary

Works approval W6580/2021/1 is held by Owens Group Pty Ltd trading as Enecell Resource Recovery Solutions (works approval holder) for the Enecell Resource Recovery Solutions premises at 10 McCook Street in Forrestdale (the premises).

The premises relates to the category and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing works approval W6580/2021/1.

On 5 November 2025 the works approval holder submitted an application to the department to amend works approval W6580/2021/1 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to:

- extending the authorised commissioning duration of environmental commissioning from 120 days to 300 days, constituting an additional 180 days, and
- changing the premises approved monthly throughput of 500 tonnes per month (Condition 8, Table 3) to an average throughput of 500 tonnes per month for clarity.

The requested amendments are administrative in nature and as such, no additional risk assessment of premises activities has been undertaken.

3. Consultation

The works approval holder was provided with the draft amendment report on 7 November 2025. On 10 November 2025 the works approval holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the revised works

approval as part of the amendment process.
