GENERAL CONDITIONS

EMISSION TO AIR

- 1. The Licence Holder must prevent visible TSP from crossing the boundary from all materials handling operations, stockpiles, open areas and transport activities.
- 2. The Licence Holder must use all reasonable and practicable means to remove rubber lining and surface treatments prior to flame cutting.
- **3.** The Licence Holder must immediately extinguish any fires which generate dark smoke emissions.
- **4.** The Licence Holder must not allow any fires on the premises to burn unattended.
- **5.** The Licence Holder must only use clean scrap in any furnace on the premises when using scrap as feedstock.

WASTE MINIMISATION / REMOVAL / STORAGE

- **6.** The Licence Holder must store on site any process wastes not suitable for on-site reuse in an impervious tank prior to removal offsite.
- 7. The Licence Holder must immediately remove any chemicals resulting from spillage or leakage of chemicals including process chemicals, process waters, fuel, oil or other hydrocarbons, whether inside or outside containment facilities.
- **8.** The Licence Holder must store the collected material referred to in condition 7, to prevent access to the environment prior to disposal.
- **9.** The Licence Holder must dispose of any solid wastes and sludges generated at the premises as a controlled waste.


REPORTING CONDITIONS

- **10.** The Licence Holder must:
 - (a) undertake an audit of their compliance with the conditions of this licence during the preceding annual period; and
 - (b) prepare and submit to the CEO by no later than 1 March after the end of that annual period an Annual Audit Compliance Report in the approved form.
