1.1 Interpretation


- (a) certify that the works were constructed in accordance with the conditions of the Works Approval; and

3 Executive summary of proposal and assessment

Fortnum Gold Mine (Fortnum) is located in the Peak Hill region of Western Australia, approximately 170 kilometres (km) north of Meekatharra, on Mining Tenements M52/96 and M52/132. The land within the project area has historically been used for grazing and is located on the Milgun Station.

The original works approval application is for dewatering of the Toms and Yarlalweelor pits. The proponent has nominated a discharge rate of 1,900,000 tonnes per year of dewatering water and therefore exceeds the production or design capacity threshold for category 6 of 50,000 tonnes or more per year.

Aragon Resources Pty Ltd (Aragon Resources) has recently bought Fortnum from Grosvenor Gold Pty Ltd. Mining tenements within the prescribed premises boundary for this site are currently being transferred to Aragon Resources. Aragon Resources have provided an appointment letter outlining that they are now the acting agents for these tenements and that the previous owners (Grosvenor Gold Pty Ltd) authorise the agents to act on their behalf in relation to these tenements with respect to compliance with the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*. Fortnum is currently in care and maintenance and Aragon Resources wish to commence mining in 2016. Aragon have requested that W5367/2013/1 be transferred to them and the expiry date extended from 6 March 2016 to 6 March 2018 to allow time to commence mining operations and to install the mine dewatering infrastructure.

During this transfer the following changes have been made to the works approval:

- Updated to the version 2.9 template;
- Expiry date has been changed from the 6 March 2016 to the 6 March 2018; and
- Inclusion of the P4 form dated 20 October 2015 in Table 1.2.1.

DER has not re-assessed the acceptability of impacts or emissions and discharges from the Premises or re-visited any existing emission controls. Where conditions have been amended in the existing works approval these have been justified in Section 4.
