PREAMBLE

*The following statements in this Preamble either paraphrase sections of the Environmental Protection Act 1986 or provide relevant background information for the licensee. They should not be regarded as conditions of licence.*

**Applicability**

This licence relates to Cord Nominees Pty Ltd T/A Hard Chrome Sales located at 160 Welshpool Road, Welshpool, which is a prescribed premises within Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987*, and includes the following operations:

- Metal Finishing (hard chrome electroplating)

This facility is prescribed within Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987 (as amended)* as outlined in Table 1;

**Table 1: Categories under which Hard Chrome Sales is prescribed.**

<i>Category number</i>	<i>Category name</i>	<i>Description</i>
48	Metal Finishing	Premises on which metals are chemically cleaned or metals, plastics or metal or plastic products are plated, electroplated, anodized, coloured or otherwise coated or finished.

**Nominal Rated Throughput**

The nominal rated throughput of the premises covered by this licence is in accordance with the following:

- Quantity of material treated: Not more than 100 tonnes per year

Any significant increase (greater than 10% per cent) above the nominal rated throughput listed shall not occur unless the licensee has been granted prior approval in writing from the Director under the provisions of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*.

**Other legal requirements**

The licensee should be aware that these conditions do not exempt the premises/licensee from other statutory obligations under the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*, or any other Acts. This includes the licensee's obligations under the:

- *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987 (as amended)*; and
- *Environmental Protection (Noise) Regulations 1997*.

**Other Relevant Information**

This premises is complemented by an engineering works (there are no licence requirements for this auxiliary activity) and specialises in the plating of hydraulic rams. To facilitate the electroplating process the chroming baths are maintained at a constant temperature of

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approximately 50°C. Approximately 200 litres of scheme water per day is required as make-up water. The chroming process does not routinely produce liquid or solid waste. However, in the event that waste is generated (eg spillage), the waste will be removed offsite by waste disposal contractor.

#### **Non-Standard Operations**

The licensee should inform the Department of Environment and Conservation at least 24 hours prior to the commencement of any planned non-standard operations which may have the potential to cause pollution.

#### **Emergency, Accident or Malfunction**

The licensee should inform the Director as soon as practicable of the identification of any discharge of waste which has occurred as a result of an emergency, accident or malfunction, or extreme weather conditions, otherwise than in accordance with any condition of this licence and has caused or is likely to cause pollution.

#### **General Requirements**

The following statements paraphrase sections of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* and are included for the information of the licensee.

- The licensee should take all reasonable and practicable measures to prevent pollution of the environment.
- The licensee shall take all reasonable and practicable measures to prevent or minimise the emission of odours from the premises.

#### **Alteration to Premises**

Prior to making any significant alterations to the premises which may affect the air, water or noise emissions from the premises the licensee must submit a proposal to the Director accompanied by supporting information and plans which allow the environmental impact of that change to be assessed.

## **CONDITIONS OF LICENCE**

In these conditions of licence, unless inconsistent with the text or subject matter:

"transport docket" means a docket/receipt provided to the licensee by a waste contractor licensed under the *Environmental Protection (Liquid Waste) Regulations 1996*;

"authorised person or inspector" means any person appointed to such a position under Section 87 or Section 88 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*;

"DEC" means Department of Environment and Conservation;

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"Director" means Director, Environmental Regulation Division of the Department of Environment and Conservation for and on behalf of the Chief Executive Officer as delegated under Section 20 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*;

"Director" or "Department of Environment and Conservation" for the purpose of correspondence means-

**GENERAL CONDITIONS**

**ANNUAL AUDIT COMPLIANCE REPORT**

- G1 The licensee shall by 1 February in each year, provide to the Director an Annual Audit Compliance Report in the form in attachment 2 to this licence, signed and certified in the manner required by Section C of the form, indicating the extent to which the licensee has complied with the conditions of this licence, and any previous licence issued under Part V of the Act for the premises, during the period beginning 1 January the previous year and ending on 31 December in that year.

**WATER POLLUTION CONTROL CONDITIONS**

**LIQUID CHEMICAL STORAGE**

- W1(a) The licensee shall store environmentally hazardous chemicals including process wastewaters, chemical solutions, fuel or other hydrocarbons (where the total volume of each substance stored on the premises exceeds 250 litres) within low permeability ( $10^{-9}$  metres per second or less) compound(s) designed to contain not less than 110% of the volume of the largest storage vessel or inter-connected system, and at least 25% of the total volume of substances stored in the compound.

- W1(b) The compound(s) described in part (a) to this condition shall:

- i) be graded or include a sump to allow recovery of liquid;

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- ii) be chemically resistant to the substances stored;
- iii) include valves, pumps and meters associated with transfer operations wherever practical. Otherwise the equipment shall be adequately protected (eg. bollards) and contained in an area designed to permit recovery of chemicals released following accidents or vandalism;
- iv) be designed such that jetting from any storage vessel or fitting will be captured within the bunded area [see for example Australian Standard 3780-1994 Section 5.7];
- v) be designed such that chemicals which may react dangerously if they come into contact, are in separate bunds in the same compound or in different compounds; and
- vi) be controlled such that the capacity of the bund is maintained at all times (eg. regular inspection and pumping of trapped uncontaminated rainwater).

W1(c) The licensee shall immediately remove and dispose of any liquid resulting from spills or leaks of chemicals including process waters, fuel, oil or other hydrocarbons, whether inside or outside the low permeability compound(s), in a manner approved by the Director.

WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT

W2(a) The licensee shall, prior to disposal store all process wastewater on-site in an impervious tank in accordance with condition W1(a) and W1 (b).

W2(b) The licensee shall provide to the Director a copy of all transport dockets associated with the removal of liquid waste from the premises.

SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL CONDITION

SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL

S1 The licensee shall provide to the Director, a copy of all transport dockets associated with the removal of solid wastes and sludges from the premises.

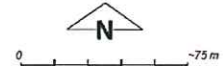
# ATTACHMENT 1 – PLAN OF PREMISES
