The production quantity for this reporting period was 388,214 tonnes, which is 278,214 tonnes above the Assessed Production Capacity. Amendment has been sought via Environmental online 12 th March 2025.

Although the excess production quantity was 3.5 times higher than the assessed production capacity, this is a relatively minor surplus given the size of the site. It is therefore expected that there will be no environmental impact resulting from the non-compliance with Condition 7.				
Cause (or suspecte	ed cause) of non-compliance:			
The excess production quantity was due to extraordinary demand from works occurring in the Southwest largely due to BORR.				
Due to labour constraints, including staff leaving and others being occupied with various tasks, we were unable to meet the deadline required by Condition 7.				
Action taken to mitigate any adverse effects of non-compliance and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance:				
B & J Catalano Pty Ltd applied on 12 th March 2025 to amend the license to increase the assessed production capacity.				
Measures have been implemented to increase labor capacity and prioritize tasks effectively to prevent late submission of reports in the future.
