1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to licence L8891/2015/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This amendment report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its regulatory framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L8891/2015/1 was previously held by BK Gold Mines Pty Ltd for the British King Gold Mine (the premises), located at Leonora WA.

The Premises relates to category 7 vat or in-situ leaching of metal and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing licence L8891/2015/1.

On 25 November 2021, Central Iron Ore Limited (the applicant) submitted an application to the department to transfer licence L8891/2015/1 into their name under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). All Mining Tenements associated with the premises are currently held by Central Iron Ore Limited (British King Gold Mine).

The amendment is limited only to a transfer of ownership of the licence and updating the occupier's registered business address.

The CEO has also determined to include minor administrative changes as part of the licence transfer, these are limited only to:

- correcting clerical mistakes and unintentional errors
- updating current DWER contact details

3. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this amendment report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

3.1 Summary of amendments
