Whilst filling a de-sludge bag at the Paraburdoo WWTP it ruptured releasing approximately 125kL of solids and wastewater. Liquid and solid waste remained within the immediate vicinity of the WWTP and was contained within the licenced premises (refer Figure 1).

The area was barricaded to prevent public and unauthorised access. The spilled material was allowed to dry and then transferred to within the de-sludging area. The spill footprint was treated with chlorine post clean-up. The de-sludge bag filling process has been amended to ensure bags are not filled to capacity. Markers have been installed to visually assess the fill capacity.
