- Are the proposed material categories practical and appropriate for local governments? Yes the proposed categories are appropriate, although we may not see large quantities of ferrous and nonferrous metals it is still appropriate to include these.
- 2. Is the annual Local Government Waste and Recycling Census template an appropriate reporting template? Yes the Waste and Recycling Census is an appropriate template to use it provides good data for use in other reporting and Local governments are familiar with it.
