## VEGETATION CONSERVATION NOTICE

**Person(s) to whom this vegetation conservation notice is given:**

**Land to which this vegetation conservation notice relates ("the land"):**

The whole of Lot 2 on Diagram 20026 as comprised on Certificate of Title Volume 2112 Folio 332.

**Reasons for which this vegetation conservation notice is served:**

This notice is given because I suspect on reasonable grounds that unlawful clearing has taken place on the land:

- (a) A site inspection by inspectors on 6 March 2007 of Lot 2 on Diagram 20026 observed that the land had been partially cleared.
- (b) An examination of aerial photography has shown that the land was cleared between December 2004 and December 2008.
- (c) This clearing is not in accordance with section 51C of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*.

**Requirements of this vegetation conservation notice:**

The persons to whom this vegetation conservation notice is given and each owner and occupier of the land who is bound by this vegetation conservation notice is required to ensure that no unlawful clearing, or no further unlawful clearing, takes place on the land.

**Important Information:**

A PERSON WHO IS BOUND BY THIS VEGETATION CONSERVATION NOTICE AND WHO DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THIS VEGETATION CONSERVATION NOTICE COMMITS AN OFFENCE UNDER THE *ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1986*.

Under section 103 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*:

- A person who is aggrieved by a requirement contained in this vegetation conservation notice may within 21 days of being given this notice lodge with the Minister for Environment an appeal in writing setting out the grounds of that appeal.
- Any other person who disagrees with a requirement contained in this vegetation conservation notice may within 21 days of the making of that requirement lodge with the Minister for Environment an appeal in writing setting out the grounds of that appeal.

PENDING THE DETERMINATION OF AN APPEAL REFERRED TO ABOVE, THE RELEVANT REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN THIS VEGETATION CONSERVATION NOTICE CONTINUE TO HAVE EFFECT.
