## **Amendment Notice**

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

The Licence Holder applied for administrative amendment to Licence L8562/2011/2 on 28 August 2018. The tonnes of biosolids accepted for compost manufacturing and soil blending activities at the Premises have been calculated as dry tonnes however, when biosolids are accepted, there is a moisture component that results in a higher tonnage being accepted. This amendment has been undertaken to reflect the moisture content weight of biosolids accepted at the Premises.

No changes to the existing operations, waste acceptance or processing are proposed and the Delegated Officer considers that this amendment is administrative in nature as it does not change the current risk profile for the Premises.
