#### Amendment

The Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) has amended the above Licence in accordance with section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act), as set out in this Amendment Notice. ## **Amendment Notice**

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

#### **Amendment description**

The existing licence held by the Water Corporation (Licence Holder) for the Roebourne Wastewater Treatment Plant is due to expire on 31 October 2018. DWER has issued this administrative amendment to extend the expiry date of the licence for a further ten years.

## Decision

The Delegated Officer has determined that the licence duration will be extended by ten years.

The Delegated Officer considers that a full review of the premises as part of a licence renewal process is not warranted at this time as the premises is low risk and DWER's Environmental Standards for Wastewater Treatment Facilities have not yet been developed. A full review of the Roebourne WWTP licence may be considered as part of DWER's risk-based licence review program. The extension does not alter the risk profile of the premises and a detailed risk assessment is not required.

### **Licence Holder's comments**

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Notice on 3 October 2018. The Licence Holder waived the remainder of their comment period on 10 October 2018 and did not have any comments.

### Amendment

1. The licence expiry date has been extended from *Wednesday, 31 October 2018* to 31 *October 2028.*
