Amendment Notice

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

This notice is limited only to an amendment for Category 12. No changes to the aspects of the original licence relating to Category 12 have been requested by the Licence Holder.

The following guidance statements have informed the decision made on this amendment:

Amendment description

Hanson Construction Materials Pty Ltd's (Hanson) has applied to increase the nominal rate of throughput for crushing and screening (category 12) from 1.5 million tonnes per year to 2.5 million tonnes per year. Hanson does not plan on changing the type of equipment used in the screening activities and already operate the site 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Given there is adequate separation to sensitive receptors, there is no change to risks and therefore no conditions will need to be added or amended.

Decision

Condition 1.2.2 has been included to the licence to limit throughput for crushing and screening activities to 2.5 million tonnes per annual period.

Hanson's Gaskell Ave operations are subject to Ministerial Statement #024 (MS 24). MS 24 requires Hanson to develop and implement a Dust Management Programme to the satisfaction of the Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety (DMIRS), as well as commitments to containing waste oils and correct fuel storage management.

The nearest sensitive receptor to the operations at Gaskell Ave is over 1.2 km to the southeast of the premises. Noise management is adequately captured under the general provisions of the *Environmental Protection (Noise) Regulations 1997*.

Licence Holder's comments

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Notice on 22 February 2018. The Licence Holder confirmed on 23 February 2018 that they were satisfied with the proposed conditions.

 - 1.2.2 The Licence Holder shall limit the total screening activities on site to a maximum 2.5 million tonnes per annual period.
