Amendment Notice

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

This notice is limited only to an amendment to the due date of submission for the Annual Environmental Report stipulated in Condition 5.2.1. No changes to the aspects of the original licence relating to Category 62 or Category 64 have been requested by the Licence Holder.

Amendment description

Under licence condition 5.2.1, the Licence Holder must submit an Annual Environmental Report within 31 calendar days after the end of the annual period (31 January 2019). Due to lengthy wait times for analysis of the sample results during the December period, the Licence Holder has lodged an application to amend the licence requesting to extend condition 5.2.1 submission date for a further 31 calendar days (03 March 2019) to submit the Annual Environmental Report.

Decision

The Delegated Officer considers the extension of the expiry date for the Licence Condition 5.2.1 is not expected to impact on the risk profile of the premises. This condition requires the lodgement of an Annual Environmental Report by a set date. Extension of the lodgement date does not modify previously approved activities at the premises. Operations will continue to be consistent with the current Licence L6925/1997/9.

The Delegated Officer has granted Amendment Notice 1 to accommodate the requested extension to the due date to 62 calendar days after the end of the annual period.
