Amendment Notice

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Existing Licence issued under the EP Act for a Prescribed Premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

The following DWER guidance statements have informed the decision made on this amendment:

- Guidance Statement: Regulatory Principles (July 2015)
- *Guidance Statement: Decision Making* (February 2017)

Amendment description

Under a previous licence, L7714/2001/5, issued on 8 May 2008, Cape Mentelle Vineyards Pty Ltd (the Licence Holder) was accepting up to 8 kL of grease trap waste per year at the premises. This was to assist in the maintenance of the crust on the anaerobic ponds to reduce odour. The licence contained a condition to measure the monthly cumulative volumes of grease trap waste and to monitor the amount of oil and grease in the outflow from the wastewater treatment system.

On 26 March 2010 DWER (then Department of Environment Conservation) received a letter from the Licence Holder stating that they were going to cease accepting grease trap waste and that they would create a vegetative layer on the anaerobic pond for odour control.

The licence, L7714/2001/6, was reissued on 28 April 2011; however; it still included the requirement for the Licence Holder to monitor the amount of grease trap waste accepted at the premises and to monitor the amount of oil and grease in the outflow from the wastewater treatment system.

The licence, L7714/2001/7, was again reissued on 1 May 2014 with the condition requiring the Licence Holder to monitor the amount of grease trap waste accepted at the premises removed. However, oil and grease monitoring unintentionally remained on the licence.

The Licence Holder has confirmed that no grease trap waste is accepted at the site and therefore this amendment is a DWER initiated amendment to remove the requirement to monitor for oil and grease in the treated wastewater.

Decision

The Delegated Officer has determined that it was an administrative error to continue to require the Licence Holder to monitor for oil and grease in the treated wastewater when licence L7714/2001/7 was reissued. As grease trap waste is not accepted at the premises, the requirement to monitor for oil and grease in the treated wastewater is not required and has been removed from the licence.

Licence Holder's comments

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Notice on 19 September 2017. No comments were received.

Amendment

1. Condition 3.5.1 of the licence is amended by the deletion of the text shown in strikethrough below:

3.5.1 The Licensee shall undertake the monitoring in Table 3.5.1 according to the specifications in that table.
