Amendment

The Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) has amended the above Licence in accordance with section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act), as set out in this Amendment Notice. This Amendment Notice constitutes written notice of the amendment in accordance with section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

Amendment Notice

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

This notice is limited to a minor amendment to reduce the frequency of groundwater monitoring for the Sinclair Nickel Operation, during care and maintenance only.

No changes to other aspects of the original Licence have been requested by the Licence Holder.

Amendment description

The Sinclair Nickel Mine has been on care and maintenance since September 2013, and there are currently no immediate plans to recommence operations at the site. Talisman Nickel Pty Ltd applied for this amendment to their Licence on 6 August 2018.

As per the conditions of the Licence, the TSF is lined with a high density polyethylene (HDPE) 1.5mm thick liner which controls any potential seepage. The ponds are also required to maintain a freeboard of 500mm to prevent overflow.

No tailings are discharged to the TSF during care and maintenance. As reported in the latest Annual Environmental Report (AER), groundwater levels and water quality of the bores surrounding the TSF have remained stable. No environmental incidents or exceedances occurred during the latest AER reporting period.

During the period that the site is on care and maintenance, Talisman Nickel Pty Ltd have requested that the monitoring required under Condition 3.4.1 in Table 3.4.1 – monitoring of five TSF groundwater bores - is reduced in frequency from quarterly to annually.

Decision

A reduction in TSF groundwater monitoring from quarterly to annually, during care and maintenance periods only, is approved.

Licence Holder controls for groundwater monitoring are conditioned on the Licence to ensure that no discharge from the TSF is occurring. Monitoring results provided in the amendment application indicate that the HDPE liner is intact, with a low risk of seepage and/or groundwater mounding from the TSF.

As no tailings are discharged to the TSF during care and maintenance, and groundwater monitoring indicates there is no impact on groundwater from the TSF, a reduction in TSF groundwater monitoring only during the care and maintenance period is approved. Quarterly groundwater monitoring at the TSF would still be required if/when operations recommences, as per the requirements of the existing Licence.

Table 3.4.1 of Condition 3.4.1 has been amended to include annual TSF groundwater monitoring during care and maintenance, and modified to specify quarterly monitoring during operations.

Licence Holder's comments

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Notice on 19 April 2019. Comments received from the Licence Holder have been considered by the Delegated Officer as shown in Appendix 2.

Amendment

The Licence duration is 19 October 2026, as per the DWER Amendment Notice issued 29 April 2016.
