Amendment Notice

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act* 1986 (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

This notice is limited only to an amendment for Category 54. No changes to the aspects of the original licence relating to Category 15 have been requested by the Licence Holder.

The following guidance statements have informed the decision made on this amendment:

- Guidance Statement: Regulatory Principles (July 2015)
- Guidance Statement: Risk Assessment (February 2017)

Amendment description

The Department of Correctional Services (the Licence Holder) operates the Karnet Prison Farm Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) and abattoir under licence L8521/2011/1.

The WWTP receives sewage from the Karnet Prison Farm and treats it through an extended aeration and caustic, coagulant and hypochlorite dosing process. A Membrane Bio Reactor (MBR) was used for the physical separation of suspended solids, some bacteria and viruses. However, during the membrane backwash cleaning process, the MBR was fouled due to an incorrect chemical being utilised.

This amendment application is therefore to modify the design of the current process and relace the MBR.

Table 1: Indicates the expected effluent quality to be achieved following the modifications:

Residual Free Chlorine	0.2 – 2.0 mg/L
Turbidity	< 2 NTU

Decision

Licence Holder controls for the modification are conditioned on the licence to ensure that emissions to land continue to comply with the emission limits specified in Condition 2.2.2 on existing Licence L8521/2011/1.

A detailed risk-assessment is not required due to there being no direct environmental risk implication/s associated with the modifications and replacement of the MBR.


Licence Holder's comments
