Amendment Notice

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence L8870/2013/1 granted to Environex International Pty Ltd (Environex). This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act on the initiative of an Officer Delegated under section 20 of the EP Act.

Licence history and background

Licence L8770/2013/1 was granted to Environex in 2013 for the operation of a chemical blending facility in Wangara that was previously operated under Licence L5848/1991/11 by Klen International (74) Pty Ltd. Klen has now relocated and operate under Licence L8882/2015/1 in Neerabup.

Environex manufactures cleaning and sanitation chemicals, sealers, and packages acids and alkalis in small containers. Air emission include volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and ammonia gas from the ammonia solution plant.

DWER has received approximately five complaints about emissions from the premises since May 2017.

Amendment description

This Amendment Notice is the result of a DWER initiated amendment and relates to the extension of the licence expiry date from 5 September 2018 to 5 September 2038.

This amendment is to extend the duration of the Licence for an additional 20 years. As part of this Amendment Notice the Delegated Officer has also:

- removed condition 4 that related to Improvement conditions that have now been complied with by the submission of the report as required by these conditions (DWER document A701742)
- removed Condition 5.1.2 as DWER now considers this general condition as redundant
- removed the superseded AACR template as the DWER *Guideline: Annual Audit Compliance Reports (2016)* has an updated AACR format; and
- included relevant definitions consequential to the above.

Decision

Section 63 of the EP Act prescribes that a licence shall continue in force for such period as is specified in the licence. In making the decision to amend the licence, the Delegated Officer had regard to DWER's *Guidance Statement: Licence Duration* that provides for the granting of a licence for up to 20 years duration.

The current Licence is due to expire on 5 September 2018. The Delegated Officer has determined that the licence duration can be extended by 20 years in line with DWER's Guidance Statement on Licence Duration.

In determining to amend the duration of the licence, the following matters were considered by the Delegated Officer:

- the premises will be subject to ongoing periodic routine compliance inspections and investigations following incidents and complaints that may occur; and
- in the event that risk issues arise in relation to the premises, the CEO may, depending on the circumstances:
 - o amend the conditions of the licence at any time;
 - in the event of an alleged offence, exercise enforcement powers under the EP Act, including an environmental protection notice; and
 - revoke the licence in the event of non-compliance with conditions causing pollution or serious environmental harm.

Minor administrative amendments have been made to the Licence and the removal of redundant conditions have also been removed from the Licence by this amendment.

Licence Holder's comments

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Notice on 7 August 2018. No comments were received from the Licence Holder

Details of the Amendment

- 1. The Licence expiry has been extended from 5 September 2018 to 5 September 2038.
- 2. Condition 1.1.2 of the Licence is amended by the insertion of the definitions shown in red underlined text and the deletion of the definitions shown in strikethrough below:

4 Improvements

- 4.1 Improvement programme
- 4.1.1 The Licensee shall complete the improvements in Table 4.1.1 by the dates specified.
- 4.1.2 The Licensee, for improvements not specifically requiring a written submission, shall write to the Director stating whether and how the Licensee is compliant with the improvement within one week of the completion date specified in Table 4.1.1.

IR2	The Licensee shall submit to the Director a report on all existing tanks holding dangerous goods or environmentally hazardous materials, identifying whether they are compliant with the standards in Condition 1.2.3 for new tanks. IR3	The Licensee shall submit to the Director a report detailing a program of improvements to bring those non-compliant tanks identified in the response to IR2. These improvements should ensure those tanks are brought up to the standards in Condition 1.2.3 based on the environmental risk from each tank.	30/11/2013

- 4. Condition 5.1.2 of the Licence is deleted as shown in strikethrough below:
 - 5.1.2 The Licensee shall ensure that:
 - (a) any person left in charge of the Premises is aware of the conditions of the Licence and has access at all times to the Licence or copies thereof; and
 - (b) any person who performs tasks on the Premises is informed of all of the conditions of the Licence that relate to the tasks which that person is performing.
- 5. Schedule 2 of the Licence is amended by the deletion of the form on the first three pages of the Schedule being the annual audit compliance report, form AACR.
