Amendment Notice

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

This notice is limited to an administrative amendment to the definitions only. No changes to the aspects of the original licence relating to Category 61A or 62 have been requested by the Licence Holder.

Amendment description

The amendment is initiated by DWER to correct the definition of 'Leachate Control System' to more accurately reflect the infrastructure at the Premises. The current definition refers to a self bunded impervious holding tank while the infrastructure at the Premises consists of two concrete liner tanks with high level alarms.

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Notice on 7 August 2017. The Licence Holder did not provide any comments.

Amendment

1. Definitions of the Licence are amended by the deletion of the text shown in strikethrough and the insertion of the red text shown in underline below:

'Leachate Collection System' means the dedicate leachate collection system constructed within the Production Area to collect leachate and direct it to a self bunded impervious holding tank; one of two of concrete lined tanks with airtight cast iron covers interconnected at bases with high level alarms and flashing strobe light;
