Amendment Notice

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

The key documents and guidance statements that have informed the decision made on this amendment are found in Appendix 1.

Amendment description

The Licence Holder has applied for an amendment to the current licence to allow an increase in the maximum quantity of solvent and waste solvent stored on the premises from 60 Kilolitres to 79 Kilolitres.

The existing bunding on site has a capacity of 10,500 litres which is sufficient bunding in accordance with Clause 4.4.3 of Australian Standard 1940:2017 The storage and handling of flammable and combustible liquids.

Consultation

The City of Cockburn was invited to comment on the proposed amendment on 5 September 2018 and replied on 14 September 2018 that they had no concerns with the change to the solvent storage capacity condition of the licence.

Decision

The Delegated Officer has considered the storage capacity of the facility and compared them with the relevant Australian Standard and accepts that the facility has the capacity to store 79 Kilolitres of solvent and waste solvent.

Licence Holder's comments

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Notice on 18 September 2018. The Licence Holder advised on the 18 September 2018 that they had no comments or concerns.

Amendment

Condition 3 of the Licence is amended by the deletion of the text shown in strikethrough below and the insertion of the red text shown in underline below:

3. The Licence Holder shall ensure that not more than 60 79 Kilolitres in total of solvent and waste solvent is stored on the premises at any one time.
