	<p>Following receipt of an Improvement Notice from DMIR as to operating procedures for the excavation, crushing screening and export of agricultural lime, the licence holder will establish a new stockpile area at a separate location to the current licenced premises for L9381/2023/1. Attachment 2 shows the location of this area and map coordinates for the land. The stockpile area is located on vegetated sandy terrain, which will be cleared with conventional earthmoving machinery in accordance with the Clearing Permit Conditions, then a limestone pad will be constructed as a base for stockpiling and truck access and loading.</p> <p>A truck turning area will also be established between the entrance to the site and the stockpile area with clearing and establishment of a limestone road surface also being conducted in accordance with the Clearing Permit Conditions.</p> <p>The operational procedure will now consist of crushing and screening at the excavation licence location, however product from the excavation area will now be transported by moxy to the new stockpile area, prior to export from the site.</p> <p>A variation to the Development Approval from the City of Albany to allow this activity is provided at attachment 3.</p> <p>As the stockpile establishment has required a Clearing Permit to be obtained from the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation.
