## 1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L4247/1991/13. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the Existing Licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

## 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### 2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L4247/1991/13 is held by Talison Lithium Australia Pty Ltd (Licence Holder) for the Talison Lithium Mine (the Premises), located at Maranup Ford Road, Greenbushes WA 6254.

The Premises relates to the category 5 and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Licence L4247/1991/13.

On 29 September 2023, the department initiated an amendment to Licence L4247/1991/13. The amendment is to:

- Increase the category 5 assessed capacity from 6,100,000 to 7,100,000 tonnes beneficiated per annual period, which was previously approved under the licence amendment granted 12 July 2023; and
- Update the meteorological station height in condition 29 Table 14.

## 3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 02 October 2023. Comments received from the Licence Holder on 02 October 2023 have been considered by the Delegated Officer as detailed in Appendix 1.

## 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

### 4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised licence as part of the amendment process.
