1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make an amendment to Licence L4297/1983/17. The amendment is administrative in nature therefore does not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendment made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L4297/1983/17 is held by Derby Industries Pty Ltd (licence holder) for the Talloman Rendering Facility (the premises).

On 29 April 2026, the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (the department/DWER) initiated an amendment to alter the reference used in Table 6 of L4297 for sampling and assessment of odour.

3. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft amendment on 4 May 2026. No comments were received from the licence holder by 26 May 2026.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended to the odour assessment and sampling method standard will be made, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments
