1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L5954/1991/12. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The Decision Report for the Existing Licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the Licence, the Department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L5954/1991/12 is held by the Water Corporation (Licence Holder) for the Kalbarri Wastewater Treatment Plant (the Premises), located on the corner of Porter Street and Atkinson Crescent, Kalbarri, WA.

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Licence L5954/1991/12.

On 5 October 2020, the Department initiated an amendment to Licence L5954/1991/12. The amendment is limited to correcting the Plan number for the prescribed premises and updating the format of the Licence.

2.3 Re-formatting of Licence

The obligations of the Licence Holder have not changed in re-formatting the licence. The Department has not undertaken any additional risk assessment of the Premises.

In re-formatting the Licence, the CEO has:

- updated the format and appearance of the Licence;
- revised Licence condition's numbers and realigned condition numbers for numerical consistency;
- corrected clerical mistakes and unintentional errors; and
- removed redundant conditions.

The full list of changes made to the Revised Licence are detailed in Section 4.1.

3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Licence and Amendment Report on 11 November 2020. On 11 December 2020, the Licence Holder waived the comment period (DWERDT389824).
