1. Decision summary

The department granted an amendment to Licence L6107/1967/17 on 1 July 2020 which included conditions for the acceptance of controlled wastes. The department became aware of an error or misdescription in the specification of a controlled waste category in condition WA1(a), therefore the CEO initiated a licence amendment to correct the error or misdescription.

The Delegated Officer has granted a further amendment to the licence that is administrative in nature to correct the error or misdescription of the controlled waste category which does not alter the previously assessed risk profile of the Premises.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

2. Description of amendment

Table 2 in condition WA1(a) of the licence, as amended on 1 July 2020, specified controlled waste category J120 (waste oil and water mixtures or emulsions, and hydrocarbons and water mixtures or emulsions). The intent of specifying controlled waste category J120 related to the receipt of ammonium nitrate emulsions at the Premises.

It has come to the department's attention that the correct controlled waste category for ammonium nitrate emulsion is E130 (Highly reactive chemicals not otherwise specified).

The receipt of this controlled waste was previously assessed in granting an amended licence on 1 July 2020. No other changes to the licence or the Premises have been considered.

3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report and draft Revised Licence on 19 March 2021. The Licence Holder advised the department of no comments.

4. Decision

In accordance with section 59(2) of the EP Act, the Delegated Officer has initiated an amendment to the licence. The Delegated Officer determined that the amendment was in accordance with section 59(1)(e) in that the amendment relates to a clerical mistake, unintentional error and/or misdescription.

The receipt of ammonium nitrate emulsions has been previously assessed in granting an amended licence on 1 July 2020. The amendment will be limited to a change from controlled waste category J120 to E130.

The Delegated Officer has given effect to the amendment by way of granting a revised licence in accordance with section 59 and 59(B) of the EP Act.

As this amendment is a correction as per section 59(1)(e) of the EP Act, it is not possible to appeal this decision (as per section 105 of the EP Act).
