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#### 1. Decision summary

Licence L6270/1991/10 is held by the Water Corporation (Licence Holder) for the Kununurra Wastewater Treatment Plant (the Premises), located at Reserve 30945, Duncan Highway Kununurra WA 6743.

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L6270/1991/10. The amendments outlined within this amendment report do not alter the risk profile of the Premises. As a result of this assessment, Revised Licence L6270/1991/10 has been granted.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The Revised Licence issued as a result of this amendment consolidates and supersedes the Existing Licence previously granted in relation to the Premises. The Revised Licence has been granted in a new format with existing conditions being transferred, but not reassessed, to the new format.

The decision report for the Existing Licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

### 2. Scope of assessment

#### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <a href="https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents">https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents</a>.

#### 2.2 Application summary

On 30 June 2023, the Licence Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Licence L6270/1991/10 under section 59 and 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to altering the due date for the environmental report and Annual Audit Compliance Report, to be 1 October annually. In amending the licence, the CEO has:

- updated the format and appearance of the Licence;
- deleted the redundant AACR form set out in schedule 1 of the previous licence and advise the licence holder to obtain the form from the department's website;
- revised licence condition's numbers, and removed any redundant conditions and realigned condition numbers for numerical consistency; and
- corrected clerical mistakes and unintentional errors.

The full summary of amendments made to this Revised Licence are detailed in Section 4.1.

The Kununurra Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) is licensed to treat up to 2000 kL/day of wastewater. It treats wastewater to a secondary standard using two series of primary, secondary, tertiary and quaternary ponds. Following pond treatment, effluent is subject to chlorination before being discharged to the M1 Channel.

The WWTP is located 1.3 kilometres southwest of the Kununurra town centre (Post Office), which is located in the Kimberley region of Western Australia and is the administrative and commercial precinct for the Ord River Irrigation Area (ORIA). The closest sensitive receptor is 1 km to the southeast, which are residents in the Kimberleyland Caravan Park. The region experiences a tropical climate with a distinct dry and wet season. The wet season is from November to April and is characterised by high temperatures, high humidity and heavy rainfall

from monsoonal and cyclonic activity, whilst the dry season is from May to October and is comprised of moderate temperatures and low rainfall. Although subject to variability, the mean annual rainfall for Kununurra is 850 mm, with the majority of this rain falling in the wet season. Constructed in 1967, the plant was upgraded in 1988. Treated wastewater from the WWTP is discharged to the Water Corporation's M1 Channel, which is located approximately 200 m to the west of the WWTP. The M1 Channel draws water from the Kununurra Diversion Dam and supplies this water via a gravity-fed system to customers on the Ivanhoe Plain of the ORIA for irrigation purposes.

Any significant degradation to the quality of the water within the M1 Channel (as a result of discharge from the Kununurra WWTP) may have impact on the suitability of the water for irrigation purposes. Notwithstanding this, the continued release of water from the Kununurra Diversion Dam into the M1 Channel during the dry season is believed to ensure that the quality of water within the channel is suitable for irrigation purposes. However during the wet season when there is little demand for irrigation water from the M1 Channel, the channel is flushed with water from the Kununurra Diversion Dam as required to ensure that the water quality within the channel is of a suitable standard.

No changes to the aspects of the Existing Licence relating to Category 54 have been requested by the Licence Holder. Table 1 below outlines the current approved production/design capacity for the Premises.

#### 3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 16 August 2023. Comments received from the Licence Holder on 22 August 2023 have been considered by the Delegated Officer as detailed in Appendix 1.

#### 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that a Revised Licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.
