Amendment Notice

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) to amend the Licence issued under the EP Act for a prescribed premises as set out below. This notice of amendment is given under section 59B(9) of the EP Act.

This notice is limited only to an amendment to extend the expiry date of the Licence. No changes to the aspects of the original licence relating to Category 64 have been requested by the Licence Holder.

Amendment description

As per condition 1.2.13 of licence L7026/1997/14, the Licence Holder must submit a closure management plan for the premises by 1 October 2018. Due to a change in staffing at the Shire of Plantagenet, this condition was not actioned.

The Licence Holder lodged an application to amend the Licence on 14 November 2018 requesting an extension to the date for submission of the closure management plan from 1 October 2018 to 1 January 2020 to allow sufficient time to develop a comprehensive closure plan.

Decision

The Delegated Officer considers that the extension of the due date for the lodgement of the Post Closure Management Plan (PCMP) required under Licence Condition 1.2.13 does not impact on the risk profile of the premises. Extension of the lodgement date does not significantly impact current or previously approved activities in the operational landfill. The Licence Holder is expected to conduct current operations so as to not be inconsistent with final landform contours, potential remedial action and other completion criteria that may be addressed in a PCMP.

The Delegated Officer has granted Amendment Notice 2 to accommodate the requested extension to the expiry date until 1 January 2020.

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Notice on 14 December 2018. Comments received from the Licence Holder have been considered by the Delegated Officer as shown in Appendix 2.

- 1.2.13 The Licence Holder must submit a Closure Management Plan for the Premises to the CEO by 1 October 2018 1 January 2020 as defined in, but not limited to, Table 1.2.6 below:
