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## 1. **Decision summary**

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to licence L7183/1997/11. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This amendment report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The amendment report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

### 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <u>https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents</u>.

#### 2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L7183/1997/11 is held by Dampier Salt Limited (licence holder) for the Port Hedland Operations (the Premises), located at the tenements ML242SA, ML250SA, M269SA, AM70/00269, AML70/00242 and AML70/00250.

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing licence L7183/1997/11.

On 15 August 2024, the department initiated an amendment to licence L7183/1997/11. The amendment is limited to amending condition 11 wording related to biennial reporting requirements.

## 3. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 19 September 2024. On 24 September 2024 the licence holder requested to waive the comment period.

## 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this amendment report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

### 4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the revised licence as part of the amendment process.
