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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L7421/1995/10 (L7421). The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

2.2 Application summary

Licence L7421/1995/10 is held by Hanson Construction Materials Pty Ltd (the Licence Holder) for the Hanson Bunbury Quarry (the Premises), located at 309 Lillydale Road, North Boyanup, WA 6237.

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Licence L7421/1995/10. The Premises is authorised for category 12 crushing and screening of basalt hard rock, with a maximum production capacity of 500,000 tonnes per annual period.

The quarry has been operated by the Licence Holder since 2003, supplying basalt to the greater Bunbury region. On 27 September 2022, the Licence Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Licence L7421/1995/10 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited to the following changes:

- Extension of the licence expiry date by five years to 2028;
- Update of premises boundary to align with Lot 27 cadastral boundary, reflecting the split of Lot 2 on Diagram 42706 into Lots 27 and 28 on Deposited Plan 419247 to allow for the construction of the Bunbury Outer Ring Road;
- Updating the stormwater monitoring locations; and
- Updating the licence to the current template format.

3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 20 January 2023 and on 13 February 2023 the Licence Holder waived the comment period.
