## Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L7475/2000/9. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

## Scope of assessment

### Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### Amendment summary

Licence L7475/2000/9 is held by Bartter Enterprises Pty Ltd (licence holder) for the abattoir branded as Steggles at 116 Howe Street, Osborne Park (the premises). The licence expires on 14 January 2025.

On 7 October 2024, the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (the department/DWER) initiated an amendment to extend the expiry date of the licence by 2 years.

The amendment is limited only to extending the licence expiry date to allow the department more time to process a full review of the Licence.

## Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft amendment on 8 October 2024. No comments were received by the licence holder.

Third party consultation did not take place given the amendment is limited to the extension of the licence term and does not change the risk profile of the premises.

## Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amendment to the expiry of the licence will be made, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.
