## 1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L7477/2001/9 (L7477). The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

## 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### 2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L7477 is held by Inghams Enterprises Pty Ltd (the licence holder) for the abattoir at 9 (Lot 68) Baden Street, Osborne Park (the Premises).

On 27 June 2024, the licence holder submitted an application to the department to amend L7477 to include the operation of a Wastewater Recycling Treatment Plant (WRTP). The application was accepted by the department. The amended licence, which included department-initiated noise assessment conditions, was provided to the licence holder on 13 January 2026.

Following discussions with the licence holder, the department initiated an amendment of L7477 to adjust the wording of Conditions 4 (c) and 7(a), so that these conditions included specific dates in which compliance is required.

The amendment is limited only to the changed wording of Conditions 4 (c) and 7(a) and is considered an administrative amendment which does not alter the risk profile of the premises

## 3. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft amendment on 2 February 2026. The licence holder responded on 3 February 2026 without any changes to the proposed amended licence and waived the remaining 21 days for consultation.

## 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended to the licence will be made, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

### 4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the revised licence as part of the amendment process.
