1. Decision summary

The delegated officer has determined to make amendments to licence L7994/2003/4. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This amendment report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its regulatory framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://www.wa.gov.au/service/building-utilities-and-essential-services/integrated-essential-services/dwer-regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L7994/2003/4 is held by the Shire of Brookton (licence holder) for the Brookton Wastewater Treatment Plant (the premises), located at Lot 448 on Deposited Plan 192654, Brookton.

The premises relates to the categories and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP regulations) which are defined in existing licence L7994/2003/4.

On 5 January 2026, the department initiated an amendment to licence L7994/2003/4. The amendment is limited to extending the licence expiry date to allow sufficient time to process a licence renewal. The renewal process will include a full review of the premises and licence.

3. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft amendment report on 12 January 2026. On 14 January 2026 the licence holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this amendment report, the delegated officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments
