1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L8004/2005/4. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L8004/2005/4 is held by Water Corporation (licence holder) for the Kambalda Wastewater Treatment Plant (the Premises), located at Crown Reserve 38893; Crown Reserve 51526; and Crown Reserve 10023 KAMBALDA WA 6391.

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing licence L8004/2005/4.

On 15 July 2025, the department initiated an amendment licence L8004/2005/4. The amendment is limited to correcting minor administrative errors which were identified by the Licence Holder post grant of the licence renewal which was issued on 4 July 2025, being:

- Permeability values for the Kambalda East and West ponds were mixed up – correct values have now been provided; and
- The AACR submission date has been incorrectly amended.

3. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft amendment report on 21 July 2025. On 22 July 2025 the licence holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the revised licence as part of the amendment process.
