1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L8111/2005/2. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the Existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L8111/2005/2 is held by Black Cat (Coyote) PTY LTD (Licence Holder) for the Tanami Gold Mine (the Premises), located at Tanami Road, Mining Lease M80/559.

The Premises relates to the categories and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Licence L8111/2005/2.

On 15 July 2022, the department initiated an administrative amendment to Licence L8111/2005/2 after it was identified that there was a typographical error in the Australian Company Number (ACN) listed on the licence. As part of the amendment, the licence has been updated to reflect the current company name (following a name change from Tanami Exploration NL), registered company address, expiry date, reporting dates and frequency requirements and definitions.

3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 5 August 2022. No comments were received.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments
