## 1. Decision summary

The delegated officer has determined to make amendments to licence L8245/2008/3. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This amendment report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

## 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its regulatory framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### 2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L8245/2008/2 is held by Water Corporation (licence holder) for the Narngulu Wastewater Treatment Plant (the premises), located at part of Lot 150 on Deposited Plan 78656 and part of Lot 1782 on Deposited Plan 248686, Narngulu.

The premises relates to the category and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing licence L8245/2008/2.

On 10 October 2024, the department initiated an amendment to licence L8245/2008/2. The amendment is limited to updating typographical errors, as summarised in Table 1 below.

## 3. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft amendment report on 23 January 2025. On 29 January 2025 the licence holder waived the comment period.

## 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this amendment report, the delegated officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.
