## 1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L8336/2009/3. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the Existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

## 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### 2.2 Application summary

Licence L8336/2009/3 is held by Mindarie Regional Council (Licence Holder) for the Mindarie Resource Recovery Facility (the Premises), located at 87 Pederick Road, Neerabup.

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Licence L8336/2009/3.

On 12 November 2025, the Licence Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Licence L8336/2009/3 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to extending licence expiry date by two years.

## 3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 17 December 2025. On 17 December 2025 the Licence Holder waived the comment period.

## 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

### 4.1 Summary of amendments
