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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L8700/2012/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Application summary

Licence L8700/2012/1 is held by Fortescue Ltd (Licence Holder) for the Kanyirri fuel Facility (the Premises), located on Miscellaneous licence S.A. 70/1 at Boodarie, WA.

The Premises relates to the category 73 (Bulk storage of chemicals etc.) and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Licence L8700/2012/1.

On 20 January 2026, the Licence Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Licence L8700/2012/1 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited to updating occupier's registered business address and rectifying a minor clerical error noted in the determination of the production/design capacity of category 73 activity. The licence specifies category 73 capacity as 6.1ML (6,100m³). However, the correct throughput based on the size of the existing storage tanks (2 x 3ML and 1 x 110kL), should be 6.11ML or 6,110m³. This minor rounding error occurred at the time of commencement of the Licence in 2016.

3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 10 February 2026. Comments received from the Licence Holder on 10 February 2026 have been considered by the Delegated Officer as detailed in Appendix 1.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised licence as part of the amendment process.
