1. Decision summary

The delegated officer has determined to make amendments to licence L8769/2013/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L8769/2013/1 is held by River Nominees Pty Ltd (licence holder) for the Purearth Organics Waste Processing Facility (the premises), located at 324 Horton Road, Woottating. The Premises relates to the categories and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing licence L8769/2013/1.

On 6 January 2026, the department initiated an amendment to licence L8769/2013/1. The amendment is limited to extending the licence expiry date by twelve months to allow the department sufficient time to undertake a thorough assessment of a renewal application received on 16 December 2025.

3. Consultation

On 10 February 2026 the licence holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the delegated officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments
