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## 1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L8868/2014/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

## 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### 2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L8688 is held by Urban Resources Pty Ltd (Licence Holder) for Maralla Road Sand Mine (the Premises), located on Part of Lot 5892 Maralla Road, Bullsbrook WA 6084. On 4 April 2024, the department initiated an amendment to Licence L8688. The amendment is limited to following items:

1. Update the prescribed premises category listed on the licence from *Category 5: processing or beneficiation of metallic or non-metallic ore* to *Category 12: Screening, etc. of material*. This change is required to accurately reflect the prescribed activities being carried out on site; being the screening of extracted raw materials (sand) from on-site.

There is no change in cost of annual fees at this stage. For further information on prescribed premises categories descriptions please refer to Schedule 1 of the [Environmental Protection Regulations 1987](#).

2. Update the expiry date on the licence to reflect formal changes made in the Amendment Notice dated 29 April 2016 – refer to <https://www.der.wa.gov.au/images/documents/our-work/licences-and-works-approvals/notice-of-amendment-of-licence-expiry-dates.pdf> (expiry date has been changed to 24 May 2036) ; and
3. ## 3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was sent the draft amendment package on 6 June 2024. No comments were received within the allocated 21-day period. A further email was sent to the Licence Holder on 16 July 2024, advising they had extra time to comment, up to 26 June 2024, otherwise the department would look to finalise the package after this date. No comments were provided.

## 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.
