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1. **Decision summary**

The Delegated Officer has determined to renew Licence L8945/2016/1. The renewal is administrative in nature as the primary activity, emissions and receptors as stated in the original approval will remain unchanged.

This Decision Report documents the changes made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In renewing the Licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

2.2 Renewal application summary and overview of Premises

On 18 December 2020, the applicant submitted an application to renew Licence L8945/2016/1 to the department under section 59B of the EP Act, as the licence is due to expire on 6 March 2021.

This renewal is limited to extending the licence expiry date. As the renewal is administrative in nature, the risk assessment for the emissions and discharges associated with the Premises has not been undertaken.

As the licence was issued with a duration of five years and the site is in care and maintenance, the department has allowed for the renewal application to contain less information than would otherwise be required for a licence renewal (DWER 2019). As such, the renewed licence has been issued for an additional 5 years to 6 March 2026, consistent with the *Guidance Statement: Licence Duration* (DER 2016).

In renewing this licence, DWER has updated the format and appearance of the licence, corrected clerical mistakes or unintentional errors, and removed any redundant conditions and realigned condition numbers for numerical consistency.

The previously issued original Decision Report will remain on the department's website for future reference of the original approved assessment and will act as a record of the department's previous decision making.
