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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to licence L8966/2016/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L8966/2016/1 is held by Appala Holdings Pty Ltd (licence holder) for the Postans Glass Processing & Waste Sorting Facility (the premises), located at 119 McLaughlan Road, Postans WA.

The premises relates to the category and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing licence L8966/2016/1.

On 10 December 2024 the department initiated an amendment to licence L8966/2016/1 to extend the licence duration for 12 months. This was to ensure the current licence continued to remain in force, while the department finalised inspection findings, and to provide sufficient time for the licence holder to complete a full renewal application for the following year. As part of that amendment, conditions relating to the preparation and submission of an Infrastructure Report, Stockpile Management Plan, and Fire Management Plan were included in the licence.

On 9 July 2025 the licence holder submitted an application for the renewal of licence L8966/2016/1. During validation of the renewal application, it was identified the Infrastructure Report, Stockpile Management Plan, and Fire Management Plan had not been received by the department. As part of a request for further information, the licence holder was requested to provide these reports before the department could accept the application. These reports were provided to the department on 17 October 2025 [DWER reference: APP-0029842 / APP-0032001 / L8966/2016/1 Documents]. Other information requested during validation of the renewal application is still outstanding, and the licence holder has requested extra time to submit these details. Extra time has been granted, however the department has determined that by the time this information is provided, there will be insufficient time to process the renewal.

As such, on 23 October 2025 the department initiated an amendment to licence L8966/2016/1 to extend the licence expiry date. This will allow time for inspection issues to be finalised, and for the licence holder to collate and submit outstanding information. A full renewal application can then be submitted at a later date. The department has determined to keep conditions relating to the preparation and submission of an Infrastructure Report, Stockpile Management Plan, and Fire Management Plan in the licence while the submitted documents are assessed.

3. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 10 November 2025. On 17 November 2025 the licence holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the revised licence as part of the amendment process.
