



## Application for Licence Amendment

## 1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L9132/2018/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

## 2. Scope of assessment

### 2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

### 2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L9132/2018/1 is held by The Beer Farm Pty Ltd (Licence Holder) for The Beer Farm (the Premises), located at 133 Gale Road, Metricup.

On 14 October 2022, the Licence Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Licence L9132/2018/1 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to extending the timeframe for completing proposed wastewater treatment works (condition 2, Table 1 items 2-11). The existing licence specifies works be completed within 90 days from the date of the licence (02 November 2022). This amendment application proposes an extension to this time by a further 60 days, with proposed works to be completed by 02 January 2023.

## 3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 10 November 2022. No comments were received from the Licence Holder.

## 4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report the delegated officer has determined to extend the completion timeframe for the wastewater treatment works and grant an amended licence subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.
