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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L9319/2022/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L9319/2022/1 is held by Australian Western Railroad Pty Ltd (Licence Holder) for the Aurizon Kwinana Rail Depot (the Premises), located at Part of Lot 511 on Deposited Plan 41203, Kwinana Beach.

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Licence L9319.

On 18 May 2022, the department initiated an amendment to Licence L9319/2022/1. The amendment is limited to correcting typographical errors and reducing reporting requirements.

3. Consultation

The Licence Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 26 May 2022. The Licence Holder did not have any comments on the draft Amendment Report or Licence.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised licence as part of the amendment process.
