1. Decision summary

The delegated officer has determined to make amendments to licence L9331/2022/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This amendment report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

1.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its regulatory framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

1.2 Amendment summary

Licence L9331/2022/1 is held by Cleanaway Daniels Services Pty Ltd (licence holder) for Cleanaway Daniels Welshpool (the premises), located at 92-94 Radium Street, Welshpool WA.

The premises relates to the category and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Licence L9331/2022/1.

The department considers there to be insufficient time to complete a licence renewal prior to the current licence expiry. Therefore, the licence duration will be extended for a short period to ensure the current licence continues to remain in force until a full assessment is able to be completed.

On 9 July 2024, the department initiated an amendment to Licence L9331/2022/1. The amendment is limited to extending the licence expiry date and correcting typographical errors.

2. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft amendment report on 31 July 2024. The licence holder responded on 1 August 2024 waiving the 21 day comment period.

3. Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised licence as part of the amendment process.
