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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Licence L9395/2023/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the existing licence will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the licence, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at <https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents>.

2.2 Amendment summary

Licence L9395/2023/1 is held by Mindarie Regional Council (licence holder) for the Tamala Park Waste Management Facility (the premises), located at 1700K Marmion Avenue, Tamala Park.

The premises relates to the categories and the assessed design capacity under Schedule 1 of the Environmental Protection Regulations 1987 (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing licence L9395/2023/1.

On 18 August 2025, the department initiated an amendment to licence L9395/2023/1. The amendment is limited to correcting specific changes that were made in the November 2023 licence amendment but were inadvertently omitted during the subsequent amendment on 16 July 2024.

3. Consultation

The licence holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 18 August 2025. On 12 September 2025 the licence holder waived the comment period.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended licence will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.

4.1 Summary of amendments

Table 1 below provides a summary of the proposed amendments and will act as a record of implemented changes. All proposed changes have been incorporated into the Revised licence as part of the amendment process.

Premises detail	The legal description of the premises' address has been updated.
1	Waste acceptance criteria updated to specify when waste can be accepted at the premises, consistent with the amendment dated 10 November 2023.
7	Phrasing changes in Table 3 that clarify the intent of daily cover requirements, consistent with the amendment dated 10 November 2023.
Definitions	Defined phrase changed from 'usual working day' to 'working day' and hours modified from '0800 – 1700 hours' to '0600 – 1800 hours', seven days a week, excluding certain public holidays, consistent with the amendment dated 10 November 2023.
