Works Approval Amendment

This amendment is made pursuant to section 59 of the *Environmental Protection Act* 1986 (EP Act) to amend Works Approval W5911/2015/1 granted under the EP Act for the Kwinana Waste To Energy Plant on Lot 9500 Leath Road, Kwinana Beach.

Details of the amendment are set out in the form of an amended works approval document and includes the consolidation of previous amendments listed in Table 2.

The Works Approval Holder applied to amend the works approval on 25 September 2019 (the Application) to ensure the works approval requirements are consistent with minor changes to its design made through internal detailed design work.

Background

Works Approval W5911/2015/1 was granted on 31 March 2016 for construction and commissioning of the Kwinana Waste to Energy Plant that will combust municipal solid waste and recover heat for electricity generation. The works approval has been subsequently amended three times as listed Table 2.

Amendment description

The Works Approval Holder requested the amendments to the works approval listed in Table 1 that relate to minor changes to design through the detailed design work phase. Some changes also relate to a change in the nominated technology provider.

Decision
