



## Amendment to Works Approval

## Scope of amendment

### Amendment summary

Works Approval W5911/2015/1 is held by Kwinana WTE Project Co Pty Ltd (Works Approval holder) for the operation of Kwinana WTE Project (the premises), issued under Part V Division 3 of the Environmental Protection Act 1986. The works approval is due to expire on 30 June 2026.

The works approval relates to the operation of a waste to energy plant, located in Leath Road Kwinana Beach. The main activities undertaken on the premises include electric power generation (Category 52), incineration (Category 60), solid waste processing (Category 61(a)), and fuel burning (Category 67), as prescribed in Schedule 1 of the Environmental Protection Regulations 1987 (EP Regulations), as defined in the original works approval.

### Decision

The Delegated Officer has determined to extend the duration of the existing works approval and corresponding time limited operations for a period of 12 months as an administrative change. The works approval is set to expire on 30 June 2026, and the works approval holder has submitted a licence application which is currently under assessment. There are timing constraints arising from a potential overlap between the determination of the licence and the expiry of the existing works approval. This extension does not alter the obligations of the works approval holder during the interim period.

The works approval duration will be extended by 12 months, now expiring on 30 June 2027, with a corresponding extension to time limited operations. This amendment is administrative in nature and does not alter the risk profile of the premises, provided that activities, emissions and receptors (stated in existing approvals) remain unchanged.

### Conclusion

Based on the amendment summary provided in this amendment report, the Delegated Officer has determined that a revised works approval will be granted, subject to conditions that are commensurate with the identified controls and necessary for administrative and reporting purposes.

In the event that risk issues arise in relation to the premises, the CEO may

- (a) amend the works approval conditions at any point, and
- (b) in the event of an alleged offence, exercise enforcement powers under the provisions of the EP Act.

### Consultation

The draft works approval and this report were provided to the licence holder on 7 May 2026. Confirmation to waive the consultation period was provided via e-mail on 12 May 2026, confirming that no representations were received in relation to the draft Works Approval or the accompanying Amendment Report.
