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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W6225/2019/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In extending the works approval duration, the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER, the department) has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

2.2 Application summary

The Shire of Ashburton (the Shire) holds works approval W6225/2019/1 for the Pilbara Regional Waste Management Facility (PRWMF) (the premises), located at Lot 550 and Lot 551 on Plan 414367, Onslow Road, Talandji WA 6710. The Premises relates to the categories and the assessed production capacity under Schedule 1 of the Environmental Protection Regulations 1987 (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W6225/2019/1.

On 3 October 2022, the Shire submitted an application to the department to extend works approval W6225/2019/1 as it intends to construct a secondary liquid waste pond under the works approval, as only one was previously constructed.

The works approval holder has completed construction of most of the other infrastructure authorised by the works approval and currently holds a Licence L9304/2021/1 for the operation of the constructed parts of the premises.

3. Consultation

The applicant was provided with the draft 'Works Approval' and 'Amendment Report' on 10 October 2022 for their review and comments. The same day, an email confirming no comment and waiving the rest of the consultation period was received.

4. Conclusion

Based on the assessment in this Amendment Report, the Delegated Officer has determined that an amended works approval will be granted, subject to conditions commensurate with the determined controls and necessary for administration and reporting requirements.
