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1. Decision summary

The Delegated Officer has determined to make amendments to Works Approval W6264/2019/1. The amendments are administrative in nature therefore they do not alter the risk profile of the Premises, providing that activities, emissions and receptors as stated in existing approvals remain unchanged.

This Amendment Report documents the amendments made pursuant to section 59 and 59(B) of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act).

The decision report for the Existing works approval will remain on the department's website for future reference and will act as a record of the department's decision making.

2. Scope of assessment

2.1 Regulatory framework

In amending the works approval, the department has considered and given due regard to its Regulatory Framework and relevant policy documents which are available at https://dwer.wa.gov.au/regulatory-documents.

2.2 Application summary

Works Approval W6264/2019/1 is held by Fortescue Metals Group Ltd (Works Approval Holder) for the Hamersley Rail Mobile Crushing and Screening Facility (the Premises), located within State Agreement Act tenement L1SA Great Northern Highway, Marble Bar, WA 6760.LaSA expires 28 November 2056 and is held by the Pilbara Infrastructure Pty Ltd,

The Premises relates to the category and the assessed production/design capacity under Schedule 1 of the *Environmental Protection Regulations 1987* (EP Regulations) which are defined in existing Works Approval W6264/2019/1.

Hamersley Rail Mobile Crushing and Screening Facility (MCSF) is prescribed for category 12 activities where material is extracted from the ground, screened, washed, crushed, milled, sized, or separated, with a design capacity of 1.5 million tonnes per annum. The MCSF will produce material required to build an overpass for the Great Northern Highway over the Hammersley Rail.

On 07 October 2022, the Works Approval Holder submitted an application to the department to amend Works Approval W6264/2019/1 under section 59B of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act). The amendment is limited only to extending works approval expiry date by two years, changing the expiry date from 08/12/2022 to 08/12/2024.

This extension is required due to delays in the construction of the Great Northern Highway Overpass. Prior to construction, it was identified that the dedication of the road reserve for the Great Northern Highway overpass location had not been completed. Completion of the road reserve dedication is required to authorise land access for road construction activities and is currently being completed by third parties. Main Roads WA (MRWA) and Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage (DPLH) are finalising this process and unable to advise the likely date for completion of this dedication and thus construction has been delayed. Works are set to continue upon resolution of land access.

3. Consultation

The Works Approval Holder was provided with the draft Amendment Report on 8 December 2022. On 8 December 2022 the Works Approval Holder waived the comment period.

Table 1 provides a summary of the consultation undertaken by the department.
